Pipe replacement outside Pine View Cottages Road surface	Complete Patching – or preferably whole of Seale Lane needs resurfacing. Funding required	SCC SCC Cllr Johnson to pursue
Surface water management at SITA landfill. Detailed design complete, to incorporate allowance for 1 in 100 year events. Not finalised. SITA inherited, but did not originate site.
