

SUMMARY MINUTES OF SEALE AND SANDS PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT  
SEALE VILLAGE HALL, SEALE ON MONDAY, 18<sup>th</sup> June 2018 at 7.30 pm

PRESENT: - Cllrs. Mr W A Nelson, Mr J Butcher and the Parish Clerk. There were 5 members of the Public present.

1. WELCOME & APOLOGIES – Apologies received: Cllr. Mr I Brown, County Cllr. M Furniss and Borough Cllr. T Rooth.
2. DECLARATION OF NON & DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS – There were no declarations made.
3. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 21<sup>st</sup> May 2018 - Minutes were confirmed and approved as correct.
