

SUMMARY MINUTES OF SEALE AND SANDS PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT
SEALE VILLAGE HALL, SEALE ON MONDAY, 20th May 2019 at 7.30 pm

1. WELCOME & APOLOGIES – Apologies received from Borough Cllr. T Rooth.
2. DECLARATION OF NON & DISCLOSABLE PECUNIARY INTERESTS – There was nothing to declare.
3. CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES OF 25th March 2019 - Minutes were confirmed and approved as correct.
